It should also be emphasized that the increases in both incidence and mortality may be a reflection of accumulating body burdens of environmental toxicants and of increased oxidative damage. There has clearly been a degradation of environmental quality. And although considerable attention has been focused on this possibility in both the scientific and lay press, more research in this area is definitely needed.
